Welcome to the next edition of the Rydon Newsletter. It's important that we keep you up to date of the building works we are carrying out and how they may impact on your community.

Progress on Site

We are pleased to report that the demolition to the site has now been completed.

The foundation works to the new hospital are 50% complete, and we are progressing with forming the concrete columns from the ground floor up to the first floor.



A storm water tank has been installed and we are progressing with the installation of the site haul road.

We will now be utilising gate 1 of the site which is off of The Rush for all deliveries coming into the site. We have a gateman who is responsible for engaging with all pedestrian visitors as well as coordinating the deliveries to site.

Concerned about dust?

The dust suppression to the site has been improved. We have increased the number of fire hydrants in use, therefore this should no longer cause you any inconvenience.

What's next?

Within the next month you will see the concrete frame progress from ground floor upwards. The associated drainage works will then be installed.

We have included a copy of our Construction timeline for the site to this newsletter. This will outline the key milestones of the project and give you guidance on when each stage of the build starts.
